Radiologic technologists must be licensed or certified in most states. Few states license MRI technologists. Requirements vary by state. To become licensed, technologists must usually graduate from an accredited program, and pass a certification exam from the state or obtain a certification from a certifying body.

The radiation therapy exam is a 200-question computer-based test that can take up to four hours to complete. To be eligible for ARRT certification, you need a high school degree and at least an associate degree in radiation therapy or a related field from an accredited program.
